FreeWay Poster & Coloring Contest

Rules for Participation

1. Students in grades K-12 may enter – subject to individual school guidelines.
2. Students in grade K-1 must color the assigned age-appropriate page. Students in grades 2-12 must use the theme given. A choice may be made within the theme boundary regarding the student’s interpretation of “theme”.
3. **Grades 2-12 posters should be 11” X 17” only. Other sizes will not be accepted.** Grades K-1 coloring pages must be taken from the enclosed originals. **Please note change in poster size**
4. Entries can not be computer generated or traced. No clip art or stencils may be used. Entries must be totally the product of the individual student.
5. No Trademark TM ® or copyright © material may be used in the poster.
6. Any art medium may be used (oil, markers, watercolor, chalk, etc.).
7. Poster entries must have the student’s name and the date printed on the front or back of the poster.
8. Only one winner per grade category, per school may be submitted to the FreeWay Foundation office.
9. All coloring pages/posters submitted to FreeWay Foundation for final judging **MUST** have a completed entry form ATTACHED to the back of the entry.
10. Scheduled deadlines must be met.

LOCAL SCHOOL JUDGING

School officials judge the coloring pages and posters at the local school level. Judging should be on the basis of originality, theme interpretation and artistic ability. After winners have been selected at the local level, the school contact must send one winning coloring page/poster entry from each grade category (refer to pg. 1) to the FreeWay Project office by the scheduled deadline. *Please do not send more than one winning coloring page/poster entry per grade category.* At the school's discretion, participants may be awarded a "Certificate of Participation" from their local school (enclosed). Posters may be featured in the FreeWay Foundation publications, promotions, and/ or correspondence throughout the year (please complete enclosed photo release form). Schools may receive copies of publications using the work of winning students in their school. *Please refer to contest timeline for dates.*

FINAL JUDGING

Winning entries from the initial round of judging will undergo final judging by FreeWay Foundation staff and designers. Entries will be judged on originality, theme interpretation and artistic ability. *Please refer to contest timeline for dates.*

CEREMONY

Awards will be presented at the Capitol Rotunda Ceremony at the Missouri Capitol Building in Jefferson City, MO on Wednesday, May 5, 2010. Winners will receive a ceremony response form prior to the ceremony to confirm their attendance (family and school representatives are welcome and encouraged to attend). If students are unable to attend, their certificate and award money will be mailed to the address listed on the entry form. State Senators and Representatives are invited to attend the ceremony to offer congratulations. (Make sure you enter the appropriate STATE (not U.S.) Senator/Representative on the entry form).

Grades K-1 Coloring Page

Each Kindergarten student will color the designated coloring page.
Each First Grade student will color the designated coloring page.

Grades 2-12 Poster Contest Theme **“My Natural High”**

Students are to format their poster like the example below. They will interpret the theme “**My Natural High**” Students should illustrate through art their favorite natural high.

Teachers can define the term natural high and ask students “what is your natural high.” Students can then create a poster based on their responses to the questions.

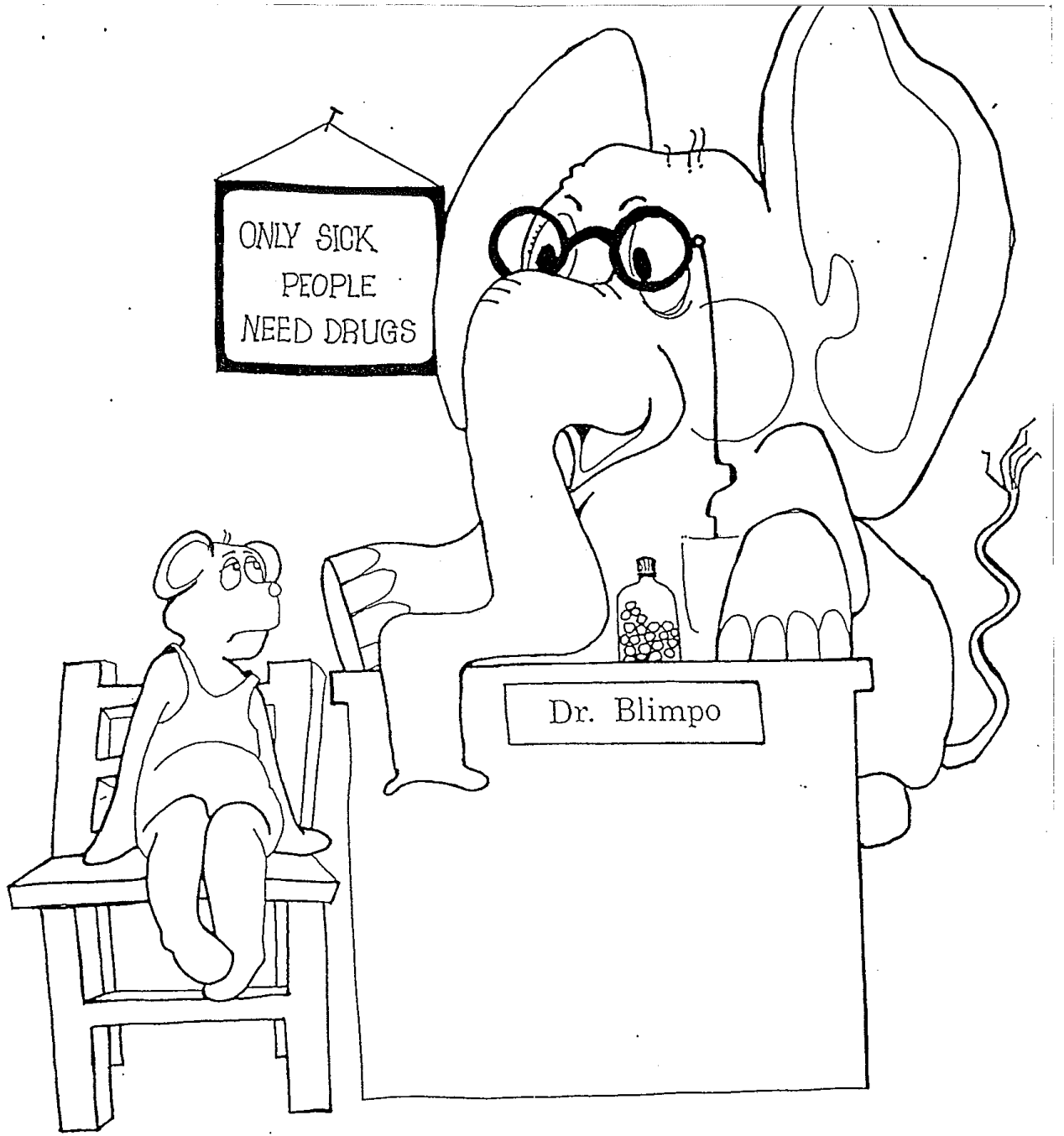
****STUDENTS MUST INCLUDE THE THEME ON THE POSTER****
